Re: Extension of Time Approval for Noise Surveys

Dear Ms. Rocan:

I grant Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company's (TGP) December 7, 2011, request for an extension of time until July 1, 2012, to file its noise surveys for Compressor Stations 303, 310, and 313 as required by environmental condition 21 of the Commission's May 14, 2010, *Order Issuing Certificate* (Order) for the 300 Line Project. TGP indicates that winter operational requirements on its system will not allow operation of the compressor station units to conduct the surveys by the current deadline. TGP states that it anticipates being able to operate the units in the spring and summer when gas is being injected into storage.
